Getting to the Kashiwa Campus

- Kashiwanoha-campus Station West Exit (Tsukuba Express Line)
<Tōbu Bus> 西柏03 for Nagareyama-ōtakanomori Station (Some buses stop at Todai-nishi stop) → get off at Todai-mae, Todai-nishi stop.
西柏04 for Edogawadai Station East Exit (via National Cancer Center) → get off at Todai-mae, Todai-nishi stop.
西柏10 for Edogawadai Station East Exit (via Midoridai-chūō) → get off at Todai-mae, Todai-nishi, Todai-nishimon-mae stop.
<By foot> about 25 minutes' walk.
- Kashiwa Station West Exit (JR Joban Line, Subway Chiyoda Line)
<Tōbu Bus> 西柏01 for National Cancer Center (via Kenmin Plaza) → get off at Todai-nishi, Todai-mae stop.
柏44 for National Cancer Center (via Customs Training Institute) → get off at National Cancer Center stop.
- Edogawadai Station East Exit (Tōbu Urban Park Line)
<Tōbu Bus> 西柏04 for Kashiwanoha-campus Station West Exit (via National Cancer Center) → get off at Todai-nishi, Todai-mae stop.
西柏10 for Kashiwanoha-campus Station West Exit (via Midoridai-chūō) → get off at Todai-nishimon-mae, Todai-nishi, Todai-mae stop.
- Joban Highway Kashiwa Interchange take Chiba direction exit to National Road number 16, after 500m turn right at the "Toyofuta Industrial Estate Entrance" crossroads.

- Kashiwanoha-campus Station West Exit (Tsukuba Express Line)
<Tōbu Bus> 西柏02 for Kashiwa Station West Exit or for 西柏05 for Takada-shako → get off at Kashiwanoha-koen-chūō, Kashiwanoha-kōkō-mae stop
西柏03 for Nagareyama-ōtakanomori Station East Exit → get off at Kashiwanoha-kōkō-mae stop
<By foot> about 15 minutes' walk.
